## Revised Mass update

The Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist are the "two Tables" from which the Lord feeds us at every Mass.

We need both the inspired Word of God and the Incarnate Word of God in the Blessed Sacrament. Pope Benedict XVI explains that these two parts of Mass have an inner unity and form "one single act of worship." The Eucharist is the "source and summit" of the Christian life and our souls longs to be nourished from both of these tables. The Word strengthens and prepares us for the bread of life. The Word is the light of the soul that guides us to the sanctuary of the Holy of Holies.
