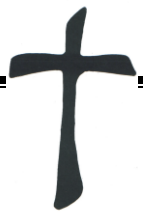
NAMING OUR NEW CATHOLIC SCHOOL

Revised Mass update

The Homily: In the Old Testament, the Levites read the "book of the Law" and helped the people in the Temple understand the law (Nehemiah 8:7-8). In the New Testament, readings from scripture and their explanations was part of Synagogue worship and Jesus helped in giving the homily in his home town synagogue (Luke 4: 18-30). From the earliest days of Christian liturgy, the Word of God was not only read during worship, it was accompanied by a homily. The word homily means "explanation" in Greek. In the early church, the Bishop was primarily the one who celebrated the Mass and gave the homily. Today, the reading of the gospel and homily at Mass is to be given only by an ordained minister: deacon, priest or bishop (those with the succession from the Apostles).
