The Christian Life Program (CLP)



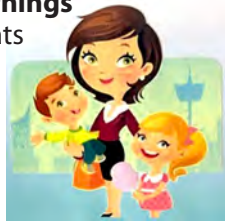

The 2019-2020 RCIA program starts **September 17** after the 7:00 pm Mass with an orientation session followed by weekly sessions until Easter Vigil.
